System Diagnostics

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
- MISSION CRITICAL FAILURE: Calculation Speed

- MISSION CRITICAL FAILURE: Revision Gaps
- STATUS: Damaged parts need repair.

PHASE 1: RECOVERY

Survive the Boards, then throttle up for JEE.

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PHASE 1 ORDERS: THE 80/20 RULE (CHEMISTRY)

Timeframe: Immediate Effect until Feb 28

PHASE 1: RECOVERY



80% If Board confidence is low, shift *80%* here. Don't let the 75% criteria kill your JEE dream.

PRIMARY OBJECTIVE: Secure >75%

Focus: Definitions, Derivations, Presentation


SECONDARY OBJECTIVE: Keep Formulae Alive
Action: Short notes revision only
Focus: Light practice to prevent rust

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TACTICS FOR BOARD IMPROVEMENT

PHASE 1: RECOVERY

THE STRATEGY	THE SHIFT: OBJECTIVE VS DESCRIPTIVE
<p>Solving the last 10 Years' PYQs guarantees ~75%+ success rate.</p> <p>Use Sample Papers to simulate writing fatigue.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- DEFINITIONS: Must be precise and textbook-accurate.- DERIVATIONS: Step-by-step logic is required. Do not skip steps.- PRESENTATION: Handwriting and formatting carry marks.



*Concept is the same, but the output is different.
You have to WRITE, not just tick options.*

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PHASE 2 ORDERS: THE MATHEMATICS PIVOT

Timeframe: Feb 28 (Evening) - Mar 9

PRIMARY OBJECTIVE (80% TIME): Mathematics Boards.
TARGET: High accuracy in lengthy calculations.

THE DROPPER ADVANTAGE

While regular 12th graders study for English and P.E., you have GAP DAYS.

PROTOCOL: Use these free days to sneak in 1 hour of intense JEE Objective Practice.

*Maths Boards is tough.
Don't underestimate the
lengthy calculations.*


PROTOCOL A (Mar 10 - 21):
 FREQUENCY: 3 Mocks / Week
 SCOPE: Full Syllabus

PROTOCOL B (Mar 22 - 31):
 FREQUENCY: DAILY Mock Test
 TIMING: 9 AM - 12 PM or
 3 PM - 6 PM

*3 Hours of Testing requires 3 Hours of Analysis.
 No exceptions.*

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PROTOCOL: REPAIR, DON'T RESTART



DO NOT

DO NOT re-watch full chapter lectures from scratch unless knowledge is zero.

Re-watching a 10-hour lecture for a topic you know 60% of is a crime.

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PROTOCOL: REPAIR

WARNING: THE 'ONLY THEORY' TRAP

PHASE 4: HAZARD WARNING



THE ILLUSION: Passive watching = Nodding head = 0 Marks.

THE REALITY: The pen must move faster than the video player.

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ACTION ITEM:

1. Stop collecting 'Formula Diaries' from influencers.
2. Stop watching 'Strategy Videos'.
3. Active Solving > Passive Watching.

New sources are just distractions in disguise.
Stick to your old notes.


RULES OF ENGAGEMENT: MOCK TESTS

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THE FEAR FACTOR

Syllabus incomplete? Irrelevant. Attempt Full Syllabus tests regardless of revision status.

THE ANALYSIS TRIAD



DEFINITIONS

BLUNDER: Missing a scheduled test (Strategic Failure).

MISTAKE: Getting a question wrong (Tactical Failure).

Scores will be low at first. Accept it. Analyze it. Improve it.

PHASE 5: MOCK ENGAGEMENT

LOGISTICS: RESOURCE DISCIPLINE

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APPROVED ASSETS

1. Previous Year Questions (PYQs) - The Holy Grail.
2. Existing Notes (Manzil/Coaching).
3. Sample Papers (Boards).



BANNED CONTRABAND

1. New Reference Books.
2. New 'Crash Course' Videos.
3. Random PDF collections.

→ PYQs are the only pool of practice you need.
2026 Jan, 2025, 2024. In that order.

PHASE 6: RESOURCE DISCIPLINE

INTEL REPORT: SHIFT-WISE VARIANCE


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INTELLIGENCE:

Exams are conducted over multiple shifts.

IMPLICATION:

'High Weightage' topics vary by shift. Do not gamble on prediction lists.



EXAMPLE: Coordinate Geometry. If you skipped it in Jan, fix it now. It could be 20% of your April paper.

Predicting the paper is impossible. Preparing for everything is possible.


PHASE 6: INFT-WISE VARIANCE

TRAINING PROTOCOL: TIME-BOUND PRACTICE

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ALIGN
BIOLOGICAL
CLOCK WITH
EXAM WINDOWS



- Stop solving questions leisurely.
- All practice must be on the clock.
- Simulate exam stress at home.

Speed comes from pressure. Apply it daily.

PHASE 6: TIME MANAGEMENT

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IS IMPROVEMENT POSSIBLE?

SUBJECT: Case Study - 96%ile to 99%ile

METHODOLOGY:

1. Zero Distractions (Instagram/WhatsApp deleted).
2. Physical Isolation (Locked in the room).
3. Unwavering Focus (No second thoughts).

MINDSET: Best of Two counts. The Jan attempt is dead. Long live the April attempt.

The magic you are looking for lies in the work you are avoiding.

- EXECUTE PHASE 1: Crush Chemistry Boards (Feb 28)
- EXECUTE PHASE 2: Crush Maths Boards (Mar 9)
